



Antiseptic Mouthwashes May Help Reduce COVID-19 Spread



COVID-19 most commonly spreads during close contact when an infected person coughs, sings, talks or sneezes. Therefore, using an effective mouthwash to kill the coronavirus may help reduce

the transmission of COVID-19 as many studies show below:

- Lab-based reports of some LISTERINE® mouthwashes have an activity against enveloped viruses including corona virus.
- · Unilever research laboratories have found that rinsing with mouthwash containing CPC (cetylpyridinium chloride chloride) technology reduces 99.9% of SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes Covid-19, after 30 seconds
- · Researchers at Cardiff University in Wales found that commercially available mouthwashes containing at least 0.07% cetylpyridinium chloride chloride (CPC) was able to inactivate the virus by 99.9% after 30 seconds of contact time.

While many laboratory experiments have shown that mouthwash can quickly kill coronaviruses, but there is no data showing that mouthwash can prevent the virus from infecting people. The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Adams School of Dentistry has launched a clinical trial to test whether mouthwash can reduce a person's risk of spreading corona virus by testing on adult COVID-19 patients. The focus of their research is to find a way to lower the risk of corona virus transmission. Results of the study are expected later this year.

If proven effective, mouthwash could be a tool to help control the transmission of COVID-19.
